### HOW SPONSORSHIP FUNDS WILL BE USED

**Hardware.** The HackBU Team does not have access to hardware. Sponsorship funds will be used to buy Raspberry Pis, breadboards, Arduinos, and/or other hardware, based on student demand.

**Food and drinks.** At the beginning of each semester, the HackBU Team hosts a General Interest Meeting (GIM) with 150+ attendees. Food and drinks encourage new and returning students to attend the GIM and subsequent workshops. More engaged students means more brand recognition and engagement at the hackathon.

**Transportation.** We will use sponsorship funds to provide transportation to Binghamton University for students at nearby universities and colleges. The HackBU team will also raffle off tickets (bus, train or plane) to other local hackathons.
