



HackBU 2019-2020 Code of Conduct

HackBU aims to create a welcoming, inclusive, and creative environment. However, this is only possible if everyone agrees to community standards. We take harassment very seriously, as everyone should be able to feel safe and have fun!

Harassment includes, but is not limited to:

1. Offensive verbal or written comments related to gender, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, religion, social class, economic status, or veteran status.
2. Unwanted sharing of sexual images/any form of unwelcome sexual attention.
3. Deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, or inappropriate physical contact.

These rules apply in all HackBU forums (in person, in any transportation to a HackBU event, and over our Discord), and all hackathon attendees are required to follow them. These rules also apply to media created during the hackathon, including hacks, graphics, text, and any other content. Use your best judgment. The HackBU team reserves the right to remove anyone engaging in harassing, offensive, or otherwise disruptive behavior.

Additionally, it's important for hackers to only stay in designated HackBU areas. The Innovative Technologies Complex (ITC) is generously offering us their space, but we only have certain rooms available. Please do not enter ITC rooms we do not have reserved, as there could be other events going on simultaneously.

Everyone who attends HackBU — including students, sponsors, faculty, organizers, and judges — agrees to this Code by attending. If you are being harassed or being made uncomfortable by someone's behavior, don't hesitate to reach out to an organizer. We're here to help!
